My mother's name is Beth. (one mother)My father's name is Jim. (one father)My brothers' names are Pete and Dave. (two brothers)My sisters' names are Ellen and Abby. (two sisters)With singular nouns, the apostrophe (') comes before the 's'.
For example:

My mother's name ... (one mother)

With plural nouns, the apostrophe comes after the 's'. For example:

My brothers' names ... (two brothers)

Use 'don't' in negative sentences with 'I', 'you', 'we' and 'they'. Use 'doesn't' in negative sentences with 'he', 'she' and 'it'. For example:

I don't like tennis.

He doesn't like tennis.

She doesn't like tennis.
